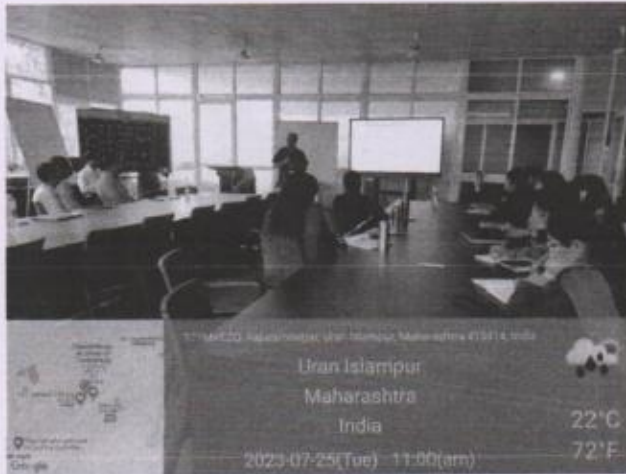
Day 2: 25 July 2023
