## R&D Policy

Research and development policy for Diploma faculty and students

### I. Faculty -

#### 1. Research Publication:

##### a. National conferences for Faculty:

Faculty member can attend such conference once in a calendar year, Registration fees for paper presentation maximum up to Rs.2,000/- and TA/DA shall be reimbursed as per Institute rules.

If faculty member wants to attend second time in a calendar year then registration fees for paper presentation maximum up to Rs.1,500/- and TA/DA shall be reimbursed as per Institute rules (once in a calendar year)

##### b. International conference for Faculty:

**Within India:** Faculty member can attend such conference once in a calendar year, Registration fees for paper presentation maximum up to Rs.5,000/- and TA/DA will be paid as per Institute rules.

**Outside India:** Faculty members can attend such conference once in a three year. Full registration fees for paper presentation and 50% Air Travel expenditure shall be reimbursed. DA will be paid on specific country visited only for the days of travelling back and forth and conference day(s).

#### 2. Research Projects: Received research grant by Govt. or private Funding agencies :

Under this scheme, Principal Investigator will be eligible to get the incentive as per following categories of the projects.



Category	Project Categories based on Amount of Research Grant received	Incentive Amount in Rs.
A	Research Grant up to Rs.1.00 Lakhs	1,000/-
B	Research Grant more than Rs.2.00 Lakhs and up to 3.00 Lakhs	2,000/-
C	Research Grant more than Rs. 3.00 Lakhs and up to Rs. 6.00 Lakhs	3,000/-
D	Research Grant more than Rs. 6.00 Lakhs	5,000/-

- When more than one person is working on the project the incentive amount will be equally divided amongst the team members or can be decided case-to-case basis.
- Incentive amount will be paid after successful completion of the said research project.

3. **MODROB proposal sanctioned by AICTE:**

Category	MODROB proposal Categories based on Amount of Sanction received	Incentive Amount in Rs.
A	MODROB proposal sanctioned less than Rs.5.00 Lakhs	2,500/-
B	MODROB proposal sanctioned more than Rs.5.00 Lakhs	5,000/-

Incentive amount will be paid after successful installation, commissioning of the Laboratory equipment(s) and the receipt of amount of revenue generated using this faculty

4. **Patents: After Commercial (Final) Registration and grantation of Patent by**

**IPO:**

Revenue generated shall be shared between faculty and institute as per IPR policy approved by BOG .





## II. Students -

### 1. National conference for Diploma students:

Students will be paid registration fees for paper presentation maximum up to Rs.1, 000/- once in calendar year.

### 2. Student participation in State, National & International level Technical Competitions:

National Level	Full Fees for Participated & Attend the event
International Level	Full Fees for Participated & Attend the event

No TA/DA will be provided.

### 3. Support for Third year Diploma Capstone projects:

Each project group in the Third year diploma will get reimbursement up to Rs. 1500/- in the group. Students need to submit bills of (Material) expenditure to concerned head of the department along with application. This reimbursement will be done R & D policy for Students.

### 4. Travelling support to students:

Diploma students will given reimbursement of one way travel expenditure for attending conference or participation in project competition within india. Students must seek prior approval from concerned HOD. Application with HOD's recommendation must be submitted to Dean Diploma for the approval.

### 5. Financial support for undertaking interdisciplinary projects:

Interdisciplinary projects at diploma institute level will get maximum funding support of Rs.5,000/- for each group.




**6. Seed funding for best Projects:**

Separate budget will be allocated for seed funding. Committee will do scrutiny of proposals submitted by students / faculty. Proposals will be selected based on merit and availability of fund in every academic year.

**7. Support for filing patents:**


Students are required to give presentation on their idea with complete working prototype in front of patent advisory committee. If idea is selected for filing patent then total expenditure on filing patent will be done by institute
