Subject: Report on F.Y.B.Tech Student Induction Program 2021-22

Dear Sir,

DTE, Maharashtra and ARA announced commencement of teaching activities from Tuesday, 07/12/21 after CAP round-I for the academic year 2021-22. As per the guidelines by AICTE, we prepared schedule of F.Y.B.Tech Student Induction Program 2021-22 or RIT-SIP 21-22. The two week SIP from 8th December 2021 to 22nd December 2021 is scheduled by the department of Sciences and Humanities for F.Y.B.Tech Students.

It is planned in such a way that fulfils the following objectives set by National Coordination Committee for Student Induction (NCC-IP) sub-committee:

1. To help new entrants adjust and feel comfortable in the RIT environment.

2. To inculcate in them the ethos and culture of RIT.

3. To help them build bonds with other new entrants, respective faculty and department.

4. To expose them to a sense of larger purpose and exploration of self.

RIT has various technical and non-technical clubs on its campus. Student coordinators along with faculty co-ordinators have introduced their respective clubs to the first-year engineering students. PPT Presentations and demonstrations were the main features of these sessions. Newly admitted students are made aware of Counselling activities in the campus, Antiragging Cell and its functioning and existence of ICC (Internal Complaint Committee). RIT offers foreign languages courses as a choice with English language. German and Japanese languages are presently the options for the first-year students in RIT. Online Screening Test for Open Language Elective course choices is conducted on the basics of English language. Open Elective (other than languages) choices are taken online on RITAGE platform. Branch-wise students were taken to the respective departments to have interaction with department faculties and to orient them with facility and laboratories in the department. In their interactive session with class-monitors, the students were made aware of the various academic and counselling practices of First Year/Sciences and Humanities department. They were also taken on institute round by respective class-monitors to let them know exact locations of facilities, labs, and lecture halls in ou Institut the campus.





Online Feedback on eSIP was taken on Google Form. Hundred and ten students registered their feedback on their participation in and effectiveness of the program. Their responses are summarized below:

- 1. 96% Students' overall impression is very good and excellent of the Student Induction Program 2021-22.
- 2. 96% Students feel that this program has changed their mindset and improved approach towards life.
- 3. 84% Students found expert lectures useful in their academic and social life.
- 4. For 95% Students tour and campus visit was useful and informative.
- 5. 98% Students have enjoyed motivational speeches.
- 6. 96% Students are now confident that their mentor is going to help them.
- 7. 96% Students have enjoyed Universal Human Value sessions conducted by mentor.
- 8. 85% Students have enjoyed morning exercises and Yoga sessions.
- 9. For 99% Students the sessions on Technical and Non-Technical Clubs were informative.
- 10. 97% Students feel that the Induction Program is well-organised.
- 11. 98% Students agreed that they have received all necessary information from their class coordinator
- 12. 98% Students agreed that they get oriented to various practices in RIT and First Year Engineering.

Every student of RIT's first year engineering has undergone four constructive and interactive sessions with mentor on universal human values. There are nine types of feelings or values in relationships. 1. Trust विश्वास (Foundation Value) 2. Respect सन्मान 3. Affection स्नेह 4. Care ममता 5. Guidance वात्सऌय 6. Reverence श्रध्दा 7. Glory गौरव 8. Gratitude कृतज्ञता and 9. Love प्रेम (Complete Value). These were discussed by mentors with students during four interactive sessions.

The Valedictory Function of the SIP and institute level Welcome Function of First Year Engineering students of RIT is conducted on Wednesday, 22/12/21. RIT intentionally planned it little late so that all students and their parents after CAP Round II can be made part of this function. Hon. Narendra Zanvar, Chairman and Managing Director, Zanvar Group of industries was the Guest of Honour of the function. Hon. Prin. Shamrao Patil (Anna) – Chairman, Rajarambapu Sakhari Bank Ltd., Peth and Member, BOG, RIT has graced the function with his presence. Almost all Deans, HoDs, faculties and supporting staff members attended this function.
